CLASS 1

Open to ANY number of members per Club **26 years of age or under** on 1st September 2007 to place FOUR HEREFORD HEIFERS in order of merit, FOUR HEREFORD BULLS in order of merit and FOUR HEREFORD COWS in order of merit. The Competitors in this Class will be expected to give reasons on their placings of the **COWS**.

CLASS 2

Open to ANY number of members per Club **21 years** of age or under on 1st September 2007 to place FOUR HEREFORD HEIFERS in order of merit, FOUR HEREFORD BULLS in order of merit and FOUR HEREFORD COWS in order of merit. The Competitors in this Class will be expected to give reasons on their placings of the **BULLS**.

CLASS 3

Open to ANY number of members per Club **18 years of age or under** on 1st September 2007 to place FOUR HEREFORD HEIFERS in order of merit, FOUR HEREFORD BULLS in order of merit and FOUR HEREFORD COWS in order of me **HEIFERS**.

RULES

1. Competitors will be allowed TEN minutes in the Rings for the purpose of placings and a further maximum of TWO minutes to give their reasons to the Judge. Competitors taking more than the allotted time for their reasons will be penalised by the deduction of 2 points for every 15 seconds or part thereof over time. ***A copy of the "Points of a Hereford" and "Hereford Cattle Judging Reasons" are enclosed for guidance.***
2. The top two competitors per Club will be designated A and B. Marks will be allocated as A and B teams.
3. A maximum of 200 marks will be awarded in respect of each competitor.
4. **DRESS: Competitors must wear clean white stock coats and Wellington boots in the interests of animal health.**
5. The first place and the Hereford Cattle Society's Silver Challenge Cup will be awarded to the Club gaining the highest aggregate marks in all three classes. A Society sketch

book will be awarded to the three Clubs gaining the highest overall team scores. A tankard will be awarded to the competitor gaining the highest individual marks.

6. The Judges will give their reasons to the general public at the conclusion of the competition.
7. Points will be awarded towards the Hereford Times Efficiency Shield, C L Coxon Cup (U21 class) and the Junior Competitions Cup (U18 class) at the following rate:-
50 points for the first place reducing by 10% down to tenth place plus 5 points (10%) for entering.
