2010 LAMB CARCASS JUDGING COMPETITION

RULES

1. This competition is open to ONE team of THREE members per Club, one under 26, one under 21 and one under 16 years of age at 1st September 2009. **THE SAME COMPETITOR CAN ENTER A MAXIMUM OF TWO CLASSES ONLY OF THE TOTAL NINE CARCASS JUDGING CLASSES.**
2. Each competitor will be required to judge ONE ring of FOUR Lamb Carcasses, place in order of merit and give reasons to the Judge on their placing.

In judging, the competitors will examine the carcasses after they have been quartered, and look for a broad eye muscle, neat but well-fleshed shoulders and for well-barrelled, short and well-fleshed ribs, for a short and neat neck and for good quality colour and texture of flesh

3. Time allowed - TEN minutes for judging of carcass, TWO minutes for giving reasons to Judge. Competitors taking more than the allotted time will be penalised by the deduction of 2 marks for every 15 seconds or part thereof taken over time.
4. COMPETITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW THEIR CURRENT PHOTO ID YFC MEMBERSHIP CARD.

2010 BEEF CARCASS JUDGING COMPETITION

RULES

Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order that the competitor places the carcasses. Only the tear-off section of the card may be used for making notes. No other papers or literature may be taken into the ring.

3. Time allowed - TEN minutes for judging of carcass, TWO minutes for giving reasons to Judge. Competitors taking more than the allotted time will be penalised by the deduction of 2 marks for every 15 seconds or part thereof taken over time.
